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Introduction

The Monterey County Sheriff's Office has an interest and responsibility for the continual growth and development of its personnel. Through a combined effort in the areas of Professional Training and Personal Education, we believe an employee can achieve both professional and personal excellence. To make professional and personal goals possible to the employee, the department has placed an emphasis in three areas: 1) Law Enforcement Education; 2) College Education and 3) Courses and Seminars offered through private providers.

Purpose

It is the policy of this office to administer a training program that will provide for the professional growth and continued development of its personnel. By doing so, the Office will ensure its personnel possess the knowledge and skills necessary to provide a professional level of service that meets the needs of the community. The Training Program Guide is a reference source for supervisors and managers to use in assessing the training needs of office employees. It is designed so that supervisors will know exactly what training is mandated by the State, POST, STC, as well as both the county and agency. It also allows for tracking development of employee expertise in their assignment and/or fields of interest.

PHILOSOPHY

The Office seeks to provide ongoing training and encourages all personnel to participate in advanced training and formal education on a continual basis. Training is provided within the confines of funding, requirements of a given assignment, staffing levels, and legal mandates. Whenever possible, the Office will use courses certified by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) and Board of State & Community Corrections (BSCC).

The Training Plan may not identify all the training that will occur for the members of the Monterey County Sheriff's Office, nor does it guarantee that a member will receive all the training that has been identified for his/her position.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Training Program are to:

- a. Enhance the level of law enforcement service to the public.
- b. Increase the technical expertise and overall effectiveness of our personnel.

- c. Provide for continued professional development of office personnel.
- d. Ensure compliance with POST rules and regulations concerning law enforcement training.

TRAINING PLAN AND OBJECTIVES

A training plan will be developed and maintained by the Training Manager. It is the responsibility of the Training Manager to maintain, review, and update the training plan on an annual basis. The plan will address the following areas:

1. Corrections Operations Bureau

24 - hours of State of California Standards and Training for Corrections (STC) per fiscal year (July 1st-June 30th). Up to 18 - hours of STC required training can be achieved via the POST required perishable skills training or other approved POST training.

2. Enforcement Operations Bureau

32 - hours of training based on the State of California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST), Federal, State, County and department identified needs within the two-year compliance cycle.

ORGANIZATION OF THE TRAINING PLAN

The Training Plan is divided into two sections:

Section 1: Rank/Position Assignment:

This section of the Training Plan contains a list of all sworn rank/positions within the structure of the Sheriff's Office.

Section 2: Task/Specialized Assignment

This section of the Training Plan is a list of all task/specialty assignments within the Office for both sworn and civilian assignments.

Within each section the training courses are categorized as follows:

MANDATED

Training in this category is required by Federal law, State law and/or Office policy. Unless otherwise noted, this training should be completed within one year of appointment to the position.

ESSENTIAL

This training has been designated by the Office as necessary for the professional development of an employee in his/her specified rank and/or task assignment.

DESIRABLE

Training that has been identified as such that will improve team capabilities, above the level of the industry standard.

In many instances an employee will be simultaneously guided by multiple sections of the Training Plan. An example would be a deputy currently assigned as a Field Training Officer. That employee will need to meet the training needs of both the Deputy rank assignment and the Field Training Officer task assignment.

CONTINUAL PROFESSIONAL TRAINING (CPT):

Continual Professional Training (CPT) is required for deputies who are employed by POST participating departments. The purpose of CPT is to maintain, update, expand, and/or enhance an individual's knowledge and/or skills. CPT is training that exceeds the training required to meet or re-qualify in entry-level minimum standards.

Every peace officer other than a Level III reserve peace officer, shall satisfactorily complete the CPT requirement of 24 or more hours of POST qualifying training during every two-year CPT cycle, beginning January 1, 2021.

Perishable Skills/Communications Requirement for CPT:

Effective January 1, 2002, all peace officers (except reserve officers) below the rank of lieutenant and assigned to patrol, investigations, or an assignment who routinely effect the physical arrest of criminal suspects are required to complete Perishable Skills and Strategic Communications training. In-lieu of completing the training, the requirement may be met by successfully passing a presenter-developed test that measures the approved training objectives.

Perishable Skills training shall consist of a minimum of 12 hours in each two-year period. Of the total 12 hours required, a minimum of 4 hours of each of the three following topical areas shall be completed:

- Arrest and Control (4 hrs.)
- Driver Training/Awareness or Driving Simulator (4 hrs.)
- Tactical Firearms (4 hrs.)

- Strategic Communications (2 hrs.)
- Use of Force (4 hrs.)

Strategic Communications training shall consist of a minimum of 2 hours in each two-year period.

It is recommended that managers and executives complete, within their two-year compliance cycle, two hours of CPT devoted to updates in the perishable skills topical areas enumerated above.

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATES and LICENSES:

The Monterey County Sheriff's Office recognizes the importance of well-trained personnel. This includes assisting Office members in obtaining the appropriate professional certificate(s) awarded by the Commission on Police Officer Standards and Training, Basic Certificate, Intermediate Certificate, Advanced Certificate, Supervisory Certificate, Management Certificate, and Executive Certificate.

To qualify for award of certificates, applicants shall have completed combinations of education, training and experience as prescribed by the Commission.

Due to the numerous combinations of training, education and experience that would qualify individuals for certificates other than the basic, it is the individual's responsibility to contact the Training Unit if they feel they are eligible for an upper-level certificate.

TRAINING NEEDS ASSESSMENT

The Training Unit will conduct an annual training-needs assessment of the Office. The needs assessment will be reviewed by staff. Upon approval by the staff, the needs assessment will form the basis for the training plan for the fiscal year.

TRAINING MANAGER

The Sheriff shall designate a Training Manager who is responsible for developing, reviewing, updating, and maintaining the office training plan so that required training is completed. The Training Manager should review the training plan annually.

TRAINING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (TMS)

This is a computer software program utilized by the Administrative Training Assistant to track all departmental training. The Training Plan for both "Rank and Task Assignments" has been entered into this software program. It is important that notification and documentation of all training be forwarded to the Training Coordinator to ensure that information is entered into the TMS program. This allows for the Training Coordinator and Training Sergeant to conduct Training Plan and P.O.S.T. and STC training compliance reports for all employees. With this capability, the Training Sergeant can identify training deficiencies according to the Training Plan.

TRAINING PROCEDURES

- a. All employees assigned to attend training shall attend as scheduled unless previously excused by their immediate supervisor. Excused absences from mandatory training should be limited to the following:
 - 1. Court appearances
 - 2. First choice vacation
 - 3. Sick leave
 - 4. Physical limitations preventing the employee's participation.
 - 5. Emergency situations
- b. When an employee is unable to attend mandatory training, that employee shall:
 - 1. Notify his/her supervisor as soon as possible but no later than one hour prior to the start of training.
 - 2. Notify the training sergeant as soon as possible but no later than one hour prior to the start of training.
 - 3. Document his/her absence in a memorandum to the chief of the employees assigned bureau and to the Chief of the Administration bureau.
 - 4. Make arrangements through his/her supervisor and the Training Manager to attend the required training on an alternate date.

TRAINING REQUESTS

All requests to attend training shall be completed on the County's Training Request Form(s) and submitted through the employee's chain of command. Include all available support literature, completed registration paperwork, hotel information, etc. Completed and approved Training Requests must be received by the Training Coordinator no later than 45 days prior to the start date of the requested course. If for any reason the forms are completed less than 45 days, please contact the Professional Standards Commander. Late applications may result in denial of the training request.

1. Training requests that are approved by the employee's supervisor, Commander, and Chief shall be forwarded to the Training Sergeant or coordinator for processing.

3. Training requests that are denied will be returned to the requesting employee detailing the reason for the denial.
